
Increase in sold production of industry as compared to December 2023

In December 2024, sold production of industry was by 0.2% higher than in December 2023, when a decrease was recorded by 3.5% as compared to the corresponding period of 2022, whereas in comparison with November 2024, it decreased by 8.0%. In the period January-December of 2024, sold production of industry was by 0.3% higher than in the corresponding period of 2023, which saw a decrease by 1.7% as compared to the corresponding period of 2022.

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in December 2024 sold production of industry reached the level lower by 0.6% than in the corresponding month of 2023 and by 1.1% lower as compared to November 2024.

After seasonal adjustment, a decrease in sold industrial production in December 2024 amounted to 0.6% per year

In December 2024, among the main industrial groupings there was an increase per year in the production of non-durable consumer goods – by 5.5%, energy – by 1.7%, durable consumer goods – by 0.8% and intermediate goods – by 0.4%. A decrease was observed in the production of capital goods – by 6.7%.



According to the preliminary data, in December 2024 as compared to December 2023, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) was reported in 20 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others in manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 16.7%, manufacture of pharmaceutical products – by 9.9%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 6.9%, manufacture of food products – by 6.5%, in waste collection, treatment and disposal activities; materials recovery – by 5.3%, in manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker – by 4.6%, in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – by 2.1%.

A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to December 2023, was recorded in 14 divisions, among others in manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 14.8%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 6.5%, manufacture of basic metals – by 5.7%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 4.8%, in manufacture of metal products – by 3.3%.

Share of production value of industry divisions, which saw an increase in comparison to December 2023, stood at 66.5%


Chart 2. Index numbers of sold production of industry by selected NACE divisions (constant prices; previous year =100)



As compared to November 2024, a decrease in sold production (in constant prices) in December 2024 was recorded in 23 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others in manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 20.8%, manufacture of furniture – by 20.7%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 20.6%, manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker – by 19.3%, manufacture of basic metals and manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 18.6% each, manufacture of metal products – by 16.5%, manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 16.2%.

An increase in sold production of industry, as compared to November 2024, was recorded in 11 divisions, among others in manufacture of other transport equipment – by 14.9%, manufacture of beverages – by 11.3%, manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 8.5%, in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – by 7.7%, in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 7.1%.
