YoY decrease in the average paid employment in the enterprise sector

In September 2024, the average paid employment in the enterprise sector compared with September 2023 was lower by 0.5% and amounted to 6 462.4 thousand full-time equivalent employees.


10.3%

YoY increase in the average monthly gross wage and salary in the enterprise sector

The average monthly wage and salary in the enterprise sector in September 2024 compared with September 2023 increased nominally by 10.3% and amounted to PLN 8 140.98 gross.

The presented data concern entities from the enterprise sector, which is part of the national economy.



In July 2024, the statutory minimum salary for work was raised to PLN 4 300 i.e. by 1.4% compared with the last increase in January 2024, when it amounted to PLN 4 242, which also affected changes in average monthly gross wages and salaries in the enterprise sector

In September 2024, there was a slight decrease in **the average paid employment** in the enterprise sector relative to August 2024 by 0.1%.


Chart 1. Average paid employment in the enterprise sector



In September 2024, the average monthly gross wage and salary in the enterprise sector decreased by 0.6% in nominal terms compared with August 2024. The decrease in wages and salaries is the result of a reduction in the scale of the additional payments that took place in the previous month.

Average monthly gross wage or salary in the enterprise sector include the base salary and additional salary components, including bonuses, awards, overtime pay and retirement severance pays

Methodological notes

The enterprise sector is part of the national economy and includes entities with 10 or more employed persons and conducting business activities². Data for the national economy are published quarterly, e.g. in the publication *Paid employment, wages and salaries in the national economy*.
