# Index numbers of sold production of industry in August 2024<sup>a)</sup>


Decrease in sold production of industry as compared to August 2023

In August 2024, sold production of industry was by 1.5% lower than in August 2023, when a decrease was recorded by 2.2% as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, whereas in comparison with July 2024, it decreased by 5.2%. In the period January-August of 2024, sold production of industry was by 0.4% higher than in the corresponding period of 2023, which saw a decrease by 2.3% as compared to the corresponding period of 2022.

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in August 2024 sold production of industry reached the level higher by 0.6% than in the corresponding month of 2023 and by 0.8% lower as compared to July 2024.

After seasonal adjustment, an increase in sold industrial production in August 2024 amounted to 0.6% per year

In August 2024, among the main industrial groupings there was a decrease per year in the production of capital goods – by 4.2%, intermediate goods – by 3.8% and smaller in the production of durable consumer goods – by 0.3%. An increase was observed in the production of non-durable consumer goods – by 2.3% and slightly in the production of energy – by 0.2%.



According to the preliminary data, in August 2024 as compared to August 2023, a decrease in sold production (in constant prices) was reported in 16 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others in manufacture of electrical equipment – by 21.4%, in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 13.8%, in manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 9.8%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 9.4%, in manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 6.2%, manufacture of metal products – by 6.0%.

An increase in sold production of industry, as compared to August 2023, was recorded in 17 divisions, among others in manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 13.7%, in waste collection, treatment and disposal activities; materials recovery – by 9.4%, in manufacture of paper and paper products – by 4.1%, manufacture of food products – by 3.9%.

Share of production value of industry divisions, which saw a decrease in comparison to August 2023, stood at 42.4%


**Chart 2. Index numbers of sold production of industry by selected NACE divisions (constant prices; previous year =100)**



As compared to July 2024, a decrease in sold production (in constant prices) in August 2024 was recorded in 27 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others in manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 11.9%, manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker – by 10.8%, manufacture of basic metals – by 10.6%, manufacture of other transport equipment – by 9.0%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products and manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 7.9% each, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 6.9%, manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 6.8%.

An increase in sold production of industry, as compared to July 2024, was recorded in 7 divisions, among others in manufacture of furniture – by 4.2%, in printing and reproduction of recorded media – by 3.4%.
