# Index numbers of sold production of industry in July 2022<sup>a)</sup>


Increase in sold production of industry as compared to July 2021

In July 2022, sold production of industry was by 7.6% higher than in July 2021, when an increase was recorded by 9.5% as compared to the previous year, whereas in comparison with June 2022, it decreased by 6.5%. In the period January-July of 2022, sold production of industry was by 12.9% higher than in the corresponding period of 2021, which saw an increase by 17.0%.

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in July 2022 sold production of industry reached the level higher by 10.2% than in the corresponding month of 2021 and by 0.5% higher as compared to June 2022.

After seasonal adjustment, an increase in sold industrial production in July 2022 amounted to 10.2% per year

In July 2022, an increase of production, as compared to previous year, was recorded in most of the main industrial groupings. The production of capital goods went up by 13.4%, energy – by 11.0%, non-durable consumer goods – by 9.3% and intermediate goods – by 5.0%. A decrease was observed in production of durable consumer goods – by 7.3%.



According to the preliminary data, in July 2022 as compared to July 2021, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) was reported in 26 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in mining of coal and lignite – by 45.4%, in manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 20.4%, manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 19.0%, manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 16.7%, manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products – by 10.0%, manufacture of food products – by 9.9%, manufacture of metal products – by 9.4%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 8.0%.

A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to July 2021, was recorded in 8 divisions, among others, in manufacture of basic metals – by 8.8%, manufacture of furniture – by 7.6%, in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 7.0%, in manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker – by 4.0%.

Share of production value of industry divisions, which saw an increase in comparison to July 2021, stood at 85.0%


**Chart 2. Index numbers of sold production of industry by selected NACE divisions (constant prices; previous year =100)**



As compared to June 2022, a decrease in sold production (in constant prices) in July 2022 was recorded in 28 industry divisions, among others, in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 28.7%, in manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 14.7%, manufacture of furniture – by 14.3%, manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker – by 13.9%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 9.7%, manufacture of metal products – by 8.5%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 7,8%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 6.6%.

An increase in sold production of industry, as compared to June 2022, was recorded in 6 divisions, among others, in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products – by 4.4%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 2.5%.
