In 2020, more than 1/2 of the national value of gross domestic product was generated in 5 regions: **Warszawski stołeczny, Śląskie, Wielkopolskie, Dolnośląskie and Małopolskie.**

Gross domestic product

In 2020, in 14 regions a growth of gross domestic product at current prices was recorded in comparison to 2019, the highest in Łódzkie region – by 4.2% and the lowest in Mazowiecki regionalny region – by 0.1 %. Whereas in the remaining 3 regions a decrease was noted.

The shares of individual regions in the generation of GDP were considerably differentiated in 2020 – from 2.0% in Opolskie region to 17.7% in Warszawski stołeczny region.

The value of GDP per capita in 2020 ranged from 41 315 PLN in Lubelskie region (68.1% of the national average) to 133 368 PLN in Warszawski stołeczny region (219.9% of the national average).

The highest level of GDP per capita obtained in 2020 in Warszawski stołeczny region exceeded over 3-times the value of GDP per capita of Lubelskie region, where the lowest level of this indicator was noted.


In 2020, an increase of gross domestic product was recorded in 14 regions

Level of GDP per capita exceeding national average was noted in 3 regions: **Warszawski stołeczny, Dolnośląskie and Wielkopolskie**


