

Kryteria grupowania danych jednostkowych z BAEL

Aggregation criteria for the individual data from the LFS

- data by age groups for which the weights are calculated, i.e. 15-17, 18-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65 years and more
- data on occupations in accordance with the ISCO classification - on the 2-digit level
- data on kinds of activity in accordance with the NACE classification - on the section level (1-digit)
- data by level of education – education (lower secondary school), primary (including incomplete primary and without education, tertiary education including tertiary with academic degree, and secondary vocational education including post-secondary education, as well as basic secondary and basic vocational education not requiring aggregation
- information concerning the subsample number removed
- data from the ZG File removed, with the exception of the information concerning a household, and data on household members (Section I A)
- in case of accessibility of data on agricultural holdings – aggregation of arable land (up to 1 ha, 1,01-5 ha, 5,01-10 ha, 10 ha and more)
- data by place of residence rural/urban – total without breakage according to town size
- duration of job seeking aggregated into 5 groups:
 - up to 3 months
 - 4-6 months
 - 7-9 months
 - 10-12 months
 - 13 months and more
- data concerning citizenship and the country of birth aggregated into 3 groups
 - Polish citizens
 - non Polish citizens, but European Union citizens
 - other (neither Polish nor EU citizens)
- data concerning fields of education – aggregated on 1-digit level
- data concerning the system of education aggregated into 2 groups – full-time school system and other systems (weekend school, evening school and other)
- data concerning the number of the employed in a company/institution – up to 10 persons jointly, while other aggregation without changes (hitherto used groups: 11-49, 50-100, 101 and more)
- data concerning regions and countries of the place of work – not disseminated
- work seniority aggregated into 5-year groups
- data concerning wages and salaries aggregated in groups of 200 zł range; the highest group being „3000 zł and more”
- data concerning the number of hours spent in education outside the regular school education system aggregated in 10-hour groups
- duration of residence in Poland in the number of years – aggregated into 2 groups: 10 years or less and more than 10 years
- the number of working hours aggregated into groups: 0-9, 10-19, 20-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60 hour and more.
