According to preliminary data, in January 2026 consumer prices increased by 2.2% compared with the corresponding month of the previous year. As related to the previous month consumer prices increased by 0.6%.

will be published 13.03.2026





**Chart 1. Changes in consumer prices<sup>b</sup> as related to the previous month (in %)**




**Chart 2. Changes in consumer prices<sup>b</sup> as related to the corresponding period of the previous year (in %)**
