

# Consumer price indices in June 2025

**Consumer prices in June 2025 increased by 4.1% compared with the corresponding month of the previous year (with an increase of prices of services by 6.3% and goods by 3.2%).**

**As related to the previous month consumer prices increased by 0.1% (of which services by 0.8%, while the prices of goods decreased by 0.2%).**

The increase of consumer prices in annual terms (4.1%) was the same as published in the flash estimate for June this year.



### Contributions of price changes to the total consumer price index


In June of the current year, compared with the previous month, the highest contribution to the total consumer price index came from higher prices related to: Recreation and culture (by 1.4%), Food (by 0.2%), Restaurants and hotels and Alcoholic beverages and Tobacco (by 0.6% each) and Communication (by 0.7%), which increased the index by: 0.10 pp, 0.04 pp and by 0.03 pp each, respectively. Lower prices related to Clothing and footwear (by 1.7%) and Transport (by 0.4%) decreased the index by 0.06 pp and 0.04 pp, respectively.

Compared with the corresponding month of the previous year, higher prices related, among others, to: Dwelling (by 8.2%), Food (by 4.8%), Alcoholic beverages and tobacco (by 6.7%), Restaurants and hotels (by 6.0%), Health (by 4.6%) and Recreation and culture (by 3.3%) increased the total index by: 1.97 pp, 1.15 pp, 0.35 pp, 0.34 pp, 0.27 pp and 0.23 pp, respectively. Lower prices related to Transport (by 6.0%) and Clothing and footwear (by 1.5%) decreased the index by 0.67 pp and 0.06 pp, respectively.


**Chart 1. Contribution of price changes of selected groups of consumer goods and services in June 2025 (change in pp compared with the previous period)**




**Chart 2. Weighting system used in the compilations of consumer price indices in 2025**



**Chart 3. Changes in consumer prices as related to the previous month (in %)**




**Chart 4. Changes in consumer prices as related to the corresponding period of the previous year (in %)**
