

# Price indices of sold production of industry in May 2026<sup>1</sup>

the increase of producer prices in industry compared to May 2025

According to preliminary data, the prices of sold production of industry in May 2026 increased compared to May 2025 – by 2.4%, and compared to the previous month, they remained at a level similar to those recorded in April this year.

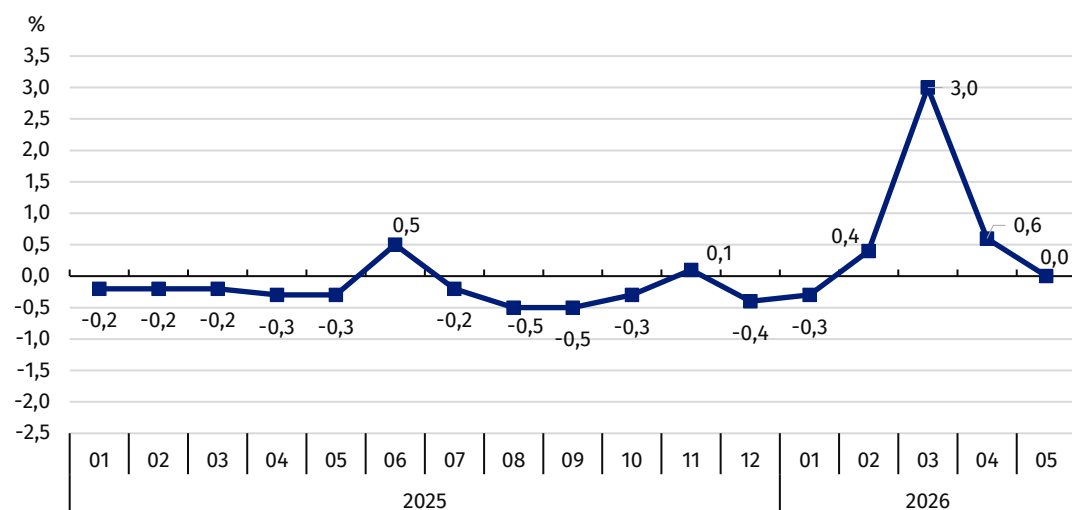

## Prices changes of sold production of industry in May 2026 compared to the previous month

According to preliminary data the prices of sold production of industry in May 2026, after increases recorded since February this year, remained at a level similar to those recorded in April 2026.

Chart 1. Prices changes of sold production of industry compared to the previous month



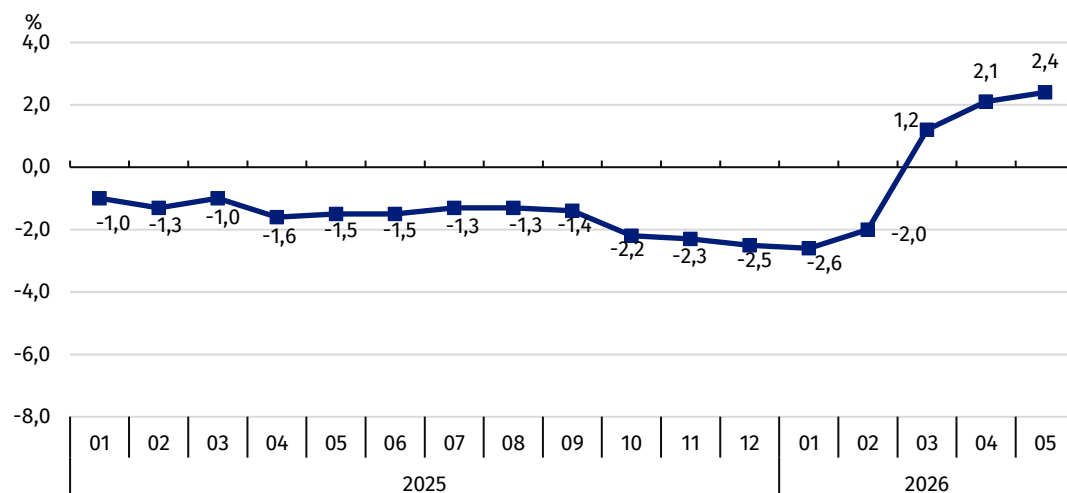
In May 2026 prices of sold production of industry remained at a level similar to those recorded in April

The price increases were recorded in **mining and quarrying** – by 1.5% (including in mining of metal ores – by 2.1%, and in mining of hard coal and lignite – by 0.7%). Prices have also been raised in the **electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply** – by 1.0%, and in **water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities** – by 0.4%. The prices have decreased in **manufacturing** – by 0.2%.

## Prices changes of sold production of industry in May 2026 compared to the corresponding month of the previous year

In May 2026 the prices of sold production of industry compared to the corresponding month of the previous year increased by 2.4%. On an annual basis the prices have increased in the last three months, following declines observed since July 2023.

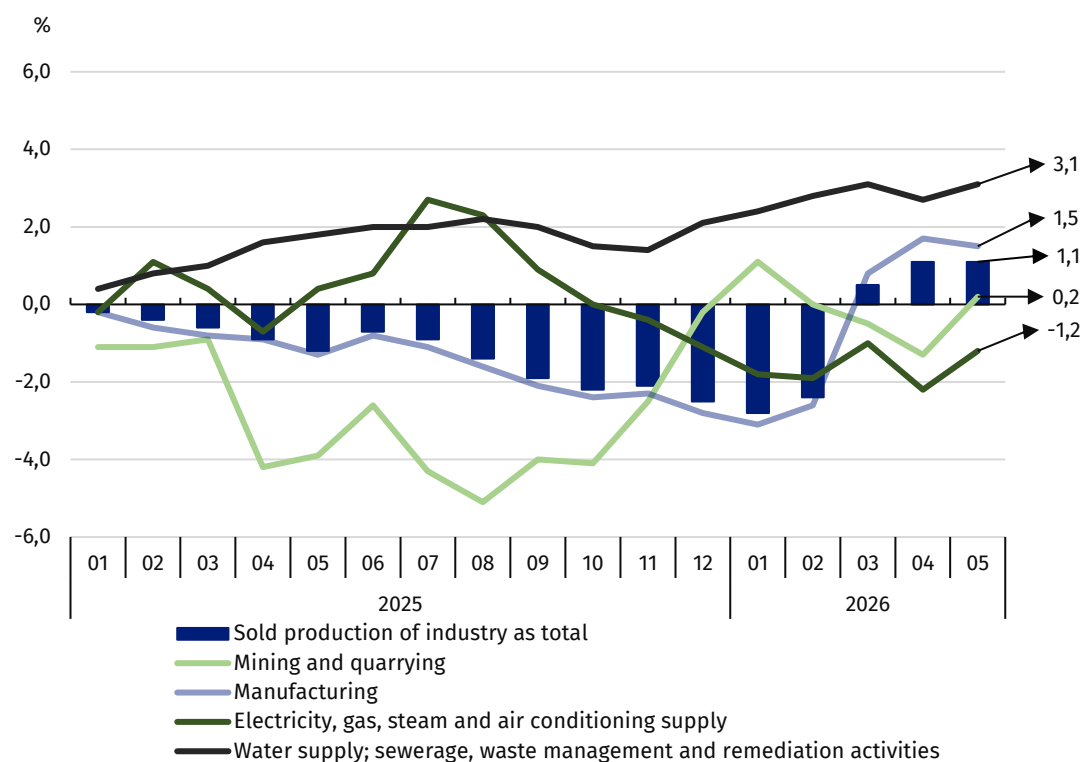
Chart 2. Prices changes of sold production of industry compared to the corresponding period of the previous year



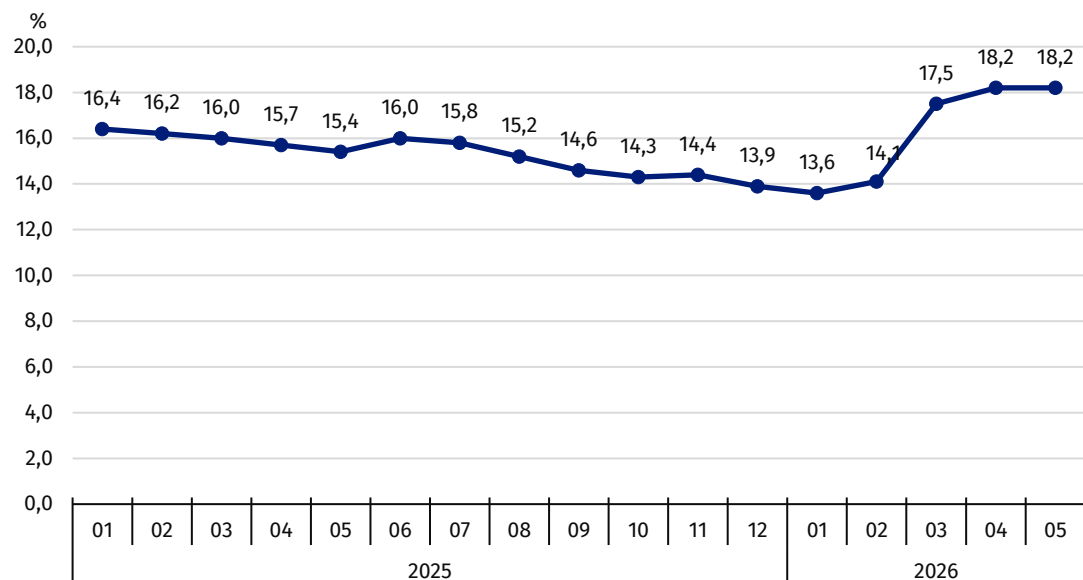
In May 2026 an increase in the dynamics of prices of sold production of industry per year was observed by 2.4%

Among the sections in industry price increases were recorded in **mining and quarrying** section – by 4.3% (including in the mining of metal ores – by 11.5%, compared to a decline in the mining of coal and lignite prices – by 3.4%). Prices have also increased in **manufacturing** section – by 2.8%, as well as in **water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities** section – by 1.3%. Lower than in May 2025 were prices in **electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply** section – by 1.6%.
