

# Statistics of Warszawa No. 6/2026

28 July 2026

In June 2026, there was a decrease in the average employment and an increase in the number of unemployed persons compared to the corresponding period of previous year. Sold production of industry as well as construction and assembly production were significantly higher than a year ago. Both retail and wholesale sales increased compared to the previous year. June 2026 was characterised by a higher number of dwellings completed than a year earlier.

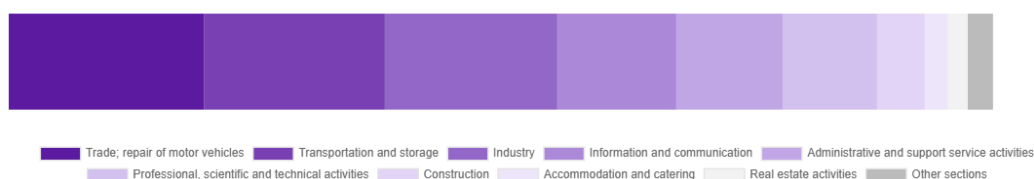
## Average paid employment

Average paid employment in the enterprise sector in June 2026 amounted to 1106.7 thousand persons (converted into full-time equivalents) and was by 0.3 thousand persons, i.e. by 0.03% larger than in May 2026, and by 7.5 thousand persons, i.e. by 0.7% smaller than in June 2025.

Compared to May 2026, the increase in the average employment was recorded in the following sections: administrative and support service activities (by 0.8%), real estate activities (by 0.2%), industry (by 0.1%).

Whereas a decrease in the average employment was recorded in the sections: construction (by 0.6%), accommodation and catering (by 0.3%), professional, scientific and technical activities, information and communication as well as transportation and storage (by 0.1% each).

Compared to June 2025, a decrease in average employment was recorded in the sections: professional, scientific and technical activities (by 7.2%), real estate activities and accommodation and catering (by 3.1% each), trade; repair of motor vehicles (by 2.0%), transportation and storage (by 1.5%), administrative and support service activities (by 0.4%).

An increase in average employment occurred in the sections: industry (by 5.2%), construction (by 1.0%), information and communication (by 0.1%).

## Registered unemployment\*

At the end of June 2026, the number of registered unemployed persons amounted to 22269 and was by 346 persons, i.e. by 1.5% smaller than at the end of May 2026 and by 2218 persons, i.e. by 11.1% larger than in the corresponding period of 2025.

The number of registered unemployed women amounted to 10734, which accounted for 48.2% of the total unemployed (48.2% a month before, and 46.6% a year before) and 18.8% of unemployed women in Mazowieckie Voivodship. As compared to May 2026, the number of unemployed women decreased by 161 persons, i.e. by 1.5%, and compared to June 2025 it increased by 1396 persons, i.e. by 14.9%.

The registered unemployment rate amounted to 1.6% (as in the previous month and 1.5% in the previous year), in Mazowieckie Voivodship it was 4.4% (4.5% a month before and 4.0% a year before), while in the country at a level of 5.8% (5.9% a month before and 5.1% a year before).

In June 2026, there were 2758 unemployed persons registered in labour offices (3081 in May 2026, and 2069 in June 2025). Registered unemployed persons accounted for 25.8% of the total registered unemployed in the Voivodship.

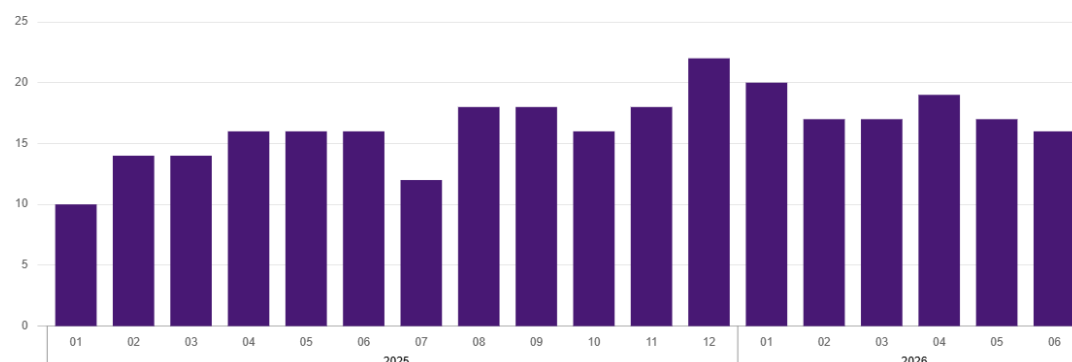
The number of persons registering for the first time amounted to 959 (1134 a month before), which accounted for 34.8% of the total unemployed who registered in June 2026 and 30.4% of persons registering for the first time in the Voivodship. The share of persons terminated due to company reasons among unemployed persons registered in June 2026 amounted to 3.6% (4.9% in Mazowieckie Voivodship), 4.7% a month before and 3.1% a year before.

In June 2026, 2770 persons were removed from unemployment rolls (2770 in May 2026, and 1736 in June 2025), which accounted for 25.7% of unemployed persons removed from unemployment rolls in Mazowieckie Voivodship. Out of the unemployed removed from unemployment rolls, 1544 persons took up work. Moreover, 1178 persons lost their status of the unemployed as a result of not maintaining contact with the labour office at least once every 90 days. The reason for removing from the register was also starting training or traineeship, acquisition of retirement or pension rights, and others.

There were 19496 persons who were not entitled to the unemployment benefit, i.e. 87.5% of the total unemployed (17270 persons a year before, i.e. 86.1%), whereas 2773 unemployed persons were entitled to the unemployment benefit.

In June 2026, there were 1827 job offers\* submitted to labour offices, which accounted for 47.6% of job offers in Mazowieckie Voivodship and at the end this month the labour offices had job offers for 1405 persons. At the end of June 2026, there were 16 persons per one job offer (17 in the previous month, the same as a year ago), while in Mazowieckie Voivodship, there were 27 persons (26 a month before, and 28 a year before) registered as unemployed.

\* On 1 June 2025, the new Act on the Labour Market and Employment Services (Journal of Laws of 2025, item 620) entered into force, introducing changes to the rules for registering and recording unemployed persons. As a result, some published data has been adjusted to reflect the current legal status and statutory terminology, which may affect the comparability of current data with previous periods.

## Wages and salaries

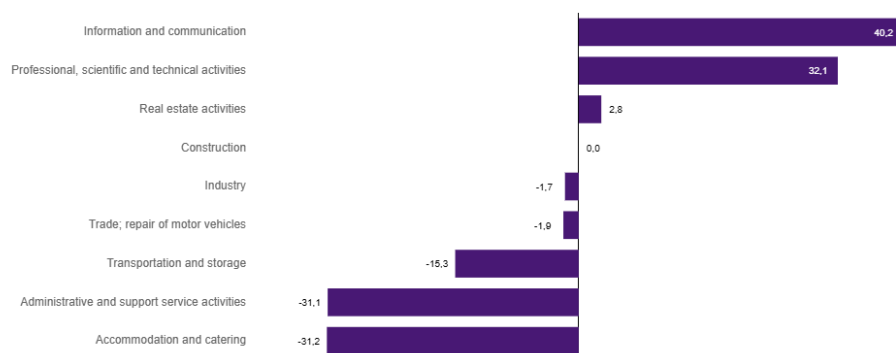
The average monthly gross wages and salaries in the enterprise sector in June 2026 amounted to PLN 11185.31 and were by 0.2% lower as compared to the previous month and by 6.6% higher than in the corresponding period of 2025.

Compared to May 2026, a decrease in the average gross wages and salaries was recorded in the following sections: information and communication (by 5.5%), construction (by 1.5%), administrative and support service activities (by 1.3%), professional, scientific and technical activities (by 0.5%).

Whereas an increase in the average gross wages and salaries was recorded in the sections: industry (by 5.3%), transportation and storage (by 1.2%), trade; repair of motor vehicles (by 1.0%), accommodation and catering (by 0.4%), real estate activities (by 0.2%).

Compared to June 2025, an increase in the average gross wages and salaries was recorded in the sections: professional, scientific and technical activities (by 11.3%), real estate activities (by 8.2%), information and communication (by 7.6%), industry (by 6.6%), transportation and storage (by 6.5%), trade; repair of motor vehicles (by 6.2%), construction (by 5.6%), accommodation and catering (by 5.1%), administrative and support service activities (by 2.3%).

### Construction

Sold production of construction in June 2026 amounted (at current prices) to PLN 6,888.6 million and compared to May 2026 was larger by 19.3% and compared to the corresponding period of previous year it increased by 0.4%.

In January-June 2026, sold production of construction reached the value of PLN 32,942.6 million, i.e. by 10.8% smaller than in the corresponding period of 2025.

Construction and assembly production in June 2026 amounted to PLN 1,893.0 million (at current prices) and accounted for 27.5% of sold production of construction. Compared to the previous month, construction and assembly production increased by 20.9%, and compared to June 2025 it was larger by 21.5%.

In January-June 2026, construction and assembly production amounted to PLN 7,966.8 million and accounted for 24.2% of sold production of construction (21.0% a year before). Compared to the corresponding period of previous year, construction and assembly production was larger by 2.8%.

The increase in production in relation to the corresponding period of 2025 occurred in units dealing with civil engineering (by 7.5%) and with construction of buildings (by 0.2%), while a decrease in production was recorded in units dealing with specialised construction activities (by 1.5%).

Labour productivity measured by production per employed person in construction in June 2026 amounted to PLN 128.4 thousand and was by 20.0% higher than a month before and by 0.6% lower than in June 2025.

### Trade

Retail sales in trade and non-trade enterprises in June 2026 (at current prices) were by 2.3% larger than in May 2026 and by 7.9% higher compared to June 2025.

Compared to May 2026, the largest increase was recorded in sales in the "others" group (by 8.8%), other retail sales in non-specialised stores (by 6.2%), sales of textiles, clothing and footwear (by 5.6%).

Whereas a decrease was recorded in sales of pharmaceuticals, cosmetics, orthopaedic equipment (by 4.3%), sales of solid, liquid and gas fuels (by 0.9%), sales of motor vehicles, motorcycles, parts (by 0.1%).

Compared to June 2025, the largest increase was recorded in sales in the "others" group (by 13.9%), other retail sales in non-specialised stores (by 12.7%), sales of newspapers, books, other retail sales in specialised stores (by 11.2%), sales of solid, liquid and gas fuels (by 9.8%), sales of furniture, electronic goods and household equipment (by 9.2%).

Whereas a decrease was recorded in sales of motor vehicles, motorcycles, parts (by 3.3%) and sales of food, beverages and tobacco (by 2.4%),

In January-June 2026, retail sales increased by 4.5% compared to the corresponding period of 2025.

Wholesale in trade enterprises in June 2026 (at current prices) was by 10.3% larger as compared to the previous month and by 21.8% higher than in June 2025, and in wholesale enterprises it was higher by 10.2% and higher by 23.2%, respectively.

In January-June 2026, retail units achieved wholesale that was 12.0% higher than a year ago, while wholesale enterprises achieved wholesale that was 15.8% higher.

## Industry

The sold production of industry in June 2026 amounted to (in current prices) PLN 15,682.7 million and was (at constant prices) larger than in the corresponding month of 2025 by 16.0%. As compared to June 2025, an increase in sold production of industry was recorded in manufacturing by 17.3%.

In the period January-June 2026, sold production of industry amounted to PLN 96,002.4 million (at current prices) and was (at constant prices) higher by 12.8% than that achieved in the same period of 2025. In manufacturing, an increase in production by 14.1% was recorded.

Among the divisions classified as manufacturing, the increase in sales was recorded, among others, in: manufacture of textiles (by 79.4%), manufacture of beverages (by 44.3%), manufacture of food products (by 42.3%), manufacture of furniture (by 33.8%), repair and installation of machinery and equipment (by 20.3%), manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products (by 18.3%), manufacture of basic metals (by 13.4%), other manufacturing (by 12.7%), manufacture of machinery and equipment n.e.c. (by 11.6%), manufacture of rubber and plastic products (by 9.1%), manufacture of pharmaceutical products (by 3.5), manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (by 2.3%), manufacture of chemicals and chemical products (by 2.0%).

The decrease in sales was recorded, among others, in: manufacture of wearing apparel (by 38.9%), manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 21.6%), manufacture of metal products (by 16.6%), manufacture of electrical equipment (by 12.2%), manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 10.1%), printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 5.8%), manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products (by 2.2%), manufacture of paper and paper products (by 0.9%).

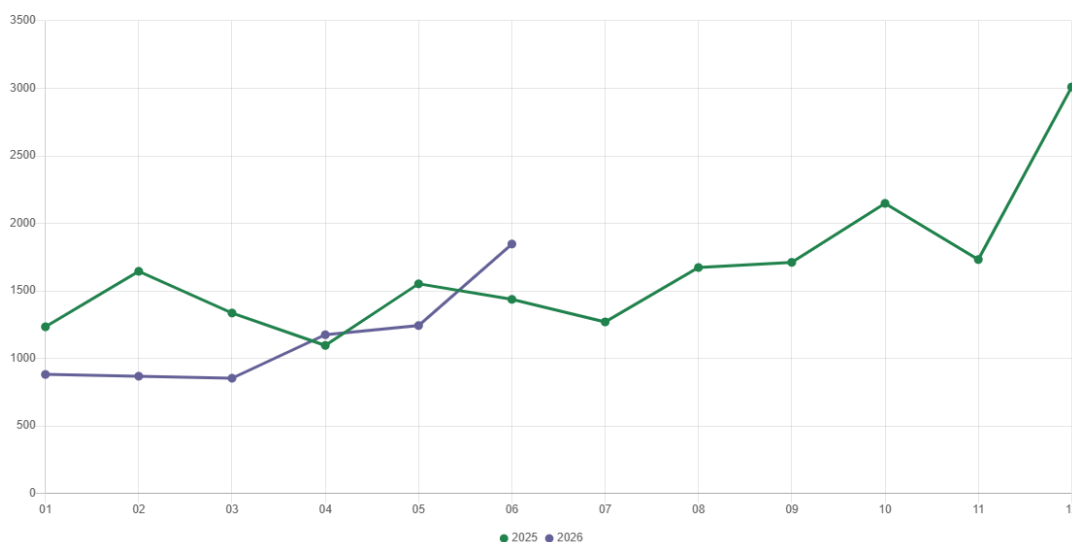
Labour productivity in industry measured by production per employed person, in January-June 2026 amounted to PLN 497.1 thousand (at current prices) and was – at constant prices – by 7.8% higher than in the previous year.

## Residential construction

According to preliminary data, 1847 dwellings were completed in Warszawa in June 2026, i.e. by 28.5% more than in the previous year.

In the period January-June 2026, 6867 dwellings were completed (by 17.3% less than in the corresponding period of 2025), and 18883 dwellings in Mazowieckie Voivodship, i.e. 3.6% less than in January-June 2025. The number of completed dwellings decreased in cooperative construction from 64 to 5, i.e., 92.2% less; in construction intended for sale or rent from 7865 to 6264, i.e., 20.4% less; and in private construction from 305 to 253, i.e., 17.0% less. Meanwhile, there was an increase in public building societies from 66 to 245, i.e., 271.2% more. Furthermore, 100 dwellings were completed in company construction between January and June 2026.

In January-June 2026, construction begun in 6528 dwellings (by 6.8% less than in the corresponding period of 2025) of which: 6260 in construction for sale or rent, 268 in private construction.

In January-June 2026, the number of dwellings for which permits have been granted or which have been registered with a construction project amounted to 7479 (by 16.8% more than in the corresponding period of 2025), of which 227 dwellings in buildings built by private investors.

The average useful floor area of a dwelling completed in January-June 2026, amounted to 62.3 m<sup>2</sup> and increased by 2.8 m<sup>2</sup> compared to the corresponding period of 2025. In private construction, the average useful floor area of dwellings amounted to 174.5 m<sup>2</sup> (by 6.7 m<sup>2</sup> less than in the corresponding period of 2025), in cooperative construction – 58.8 m<sup>2</sup> (by 9.4 m<sup>2</sup> more), in construction for sale or rent – 58.8 m<sup>2</sup> (by 3.9 m<sup>2</sup> more), in public building societies – 45.8 m<sup>2</sup> (by 4.1 m<sup>2</sup> less), in company construction – 35.8 m<sup>2</sup>.

### **Entities of the national economy**

At the end of June 2026, there were 275015 entities of the national economy registered in the REGON register in Warszawa, which accounted for 55.0% of the total in Mazowieckie Voivodship. Compared with May 2026, the number of entities of the national economy increased by 1590 (i.e. by 0.3%), and compared to June 2025 increased by 21127 (i.e. by 3.6%).

As of the end of June this year, there were 274150 legal persons and organisational units without legal personality registered in the REGON register, of which 199737 commercial companies. The number of these entities increased by 0.3% each, respectively, compared to the previous month, by 3.7% and 4.3%, respectively, on an annual basis.

The number of registered natural persons conducting economic activity as of the end of June 2026 amounted to 333908 and compared to May 2026 it was higher by 0.2%, and compared to the corresponding period of the previous year increased by 3.5%.

In Warszawa, in June 2026, the most numerous were entities dealing with: professional, scientific and technical activities (19.4% of total registered units), trade; repair of motor vehicles (15.5%), as well as information and communication (13.1%).

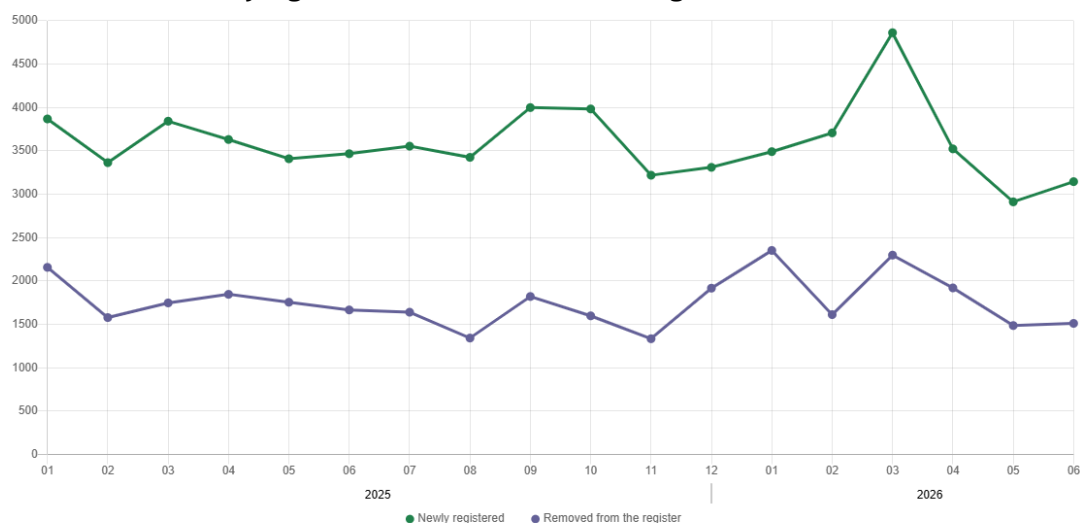
Compared to May 2026, the number of entities increased, among others, in the sections: financial and insurance activities and administrative and support service activities (by 0.5% each), public administration and defence; compulsory social security, electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply, real estate activities, construction (by 0.4%). However there was a decrease in the number of entities in the sections: mining and quarrying (by 0.8%), water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 0.2%).

Compared to June 2025, the largest increase in the number of entities was recorded, among others, in the sections: administrative and support service activities (by 9.1%), electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 6.5%), human health and social work activities (by 6.5%), education (by 5.6%), construction (by 5.3%), information and communication (by 4.5%).

Whereas a decrease in the number of entities was noted in the sections: mining and quarrying (by 3.4%), agriculture, forestry and fishing (by 1.8%), water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 1.0%), trade; repair of motor vehicles (by 0.3%).

In June 2026, 3146 new entities were entered into the REGON register, i.e. by 8.0% more than in the previous month. The newly registered entities were dominated by natural persons conducting economic activity – 1782 (by 5.6% more than in May 2026). The number of newly registered commercial companies was smaller compared to the previous month by 12.4%, including limited liability companies – larger by 13.0%.

In June 2026, 1512 entities were removed from the REGON register (compared to 1487 in the previous month), including 965 natural persons conducting economic activity (by 0.2% more).

As of the end of June 2026, 76663 entities had suspended activity in the REGON register (by 0.9% more than a month before). The vast majority were natural persons conducting economic activity (90.5%).
