According to preliminary data, the prices of sold production of industry in July 2026 increased both compared to July 2025 – by 2.8%, to the previous month – by 0.6%.

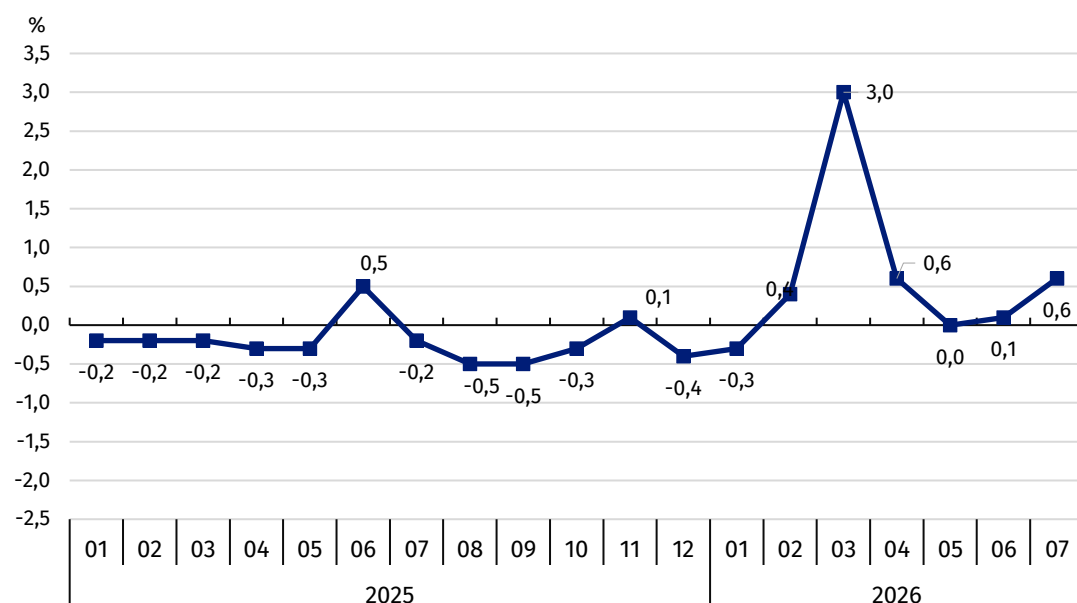

Prices changes of sold production of industry in July 2026 compared to the previous month

According to preliminary data the prices of sold production of industry in July 2026, increased by 0.6%. This is another month which prices have risen slightly.

Chart 1. Prices changes of sold production of industry compared to the previous month



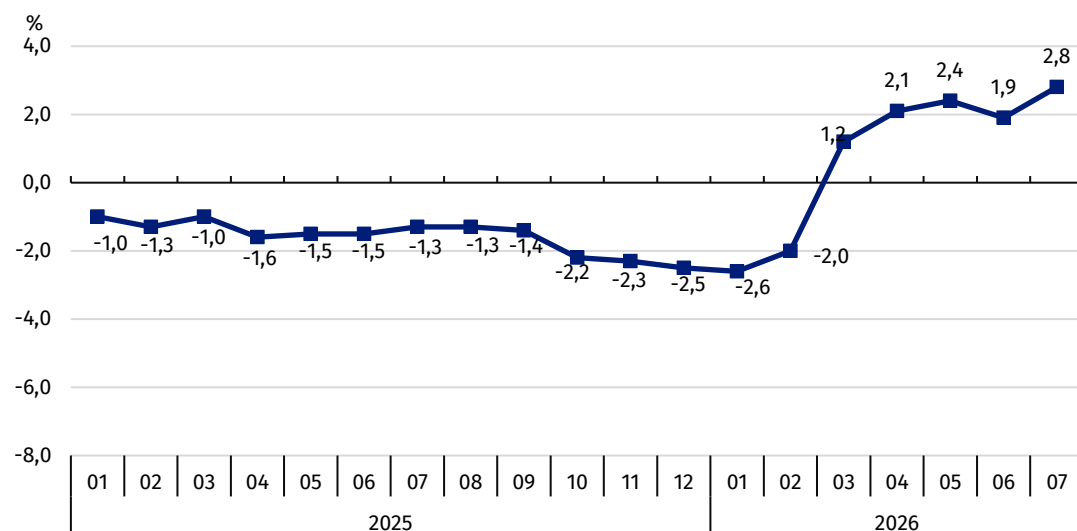
In July 2026 prices of sold production of industry increased by 0.6% compared to June 2026

In July 2026 price increases were observed in **manufacturing** – by 0.7%, and in the **electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply** – by 0.3%, as well as in **water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities** by 0.2%. However prices decreased in **mining and quarrying** - by 0.2%.

Prices changes of sold production of industry in July 2026 compared to the corresponding month of the previous year

In July 2026 the prices of sold production of industry compared to the corresponding month of the previous year increased by 2.8%. In annual terms a rise in prices has been recorded since March of this year.

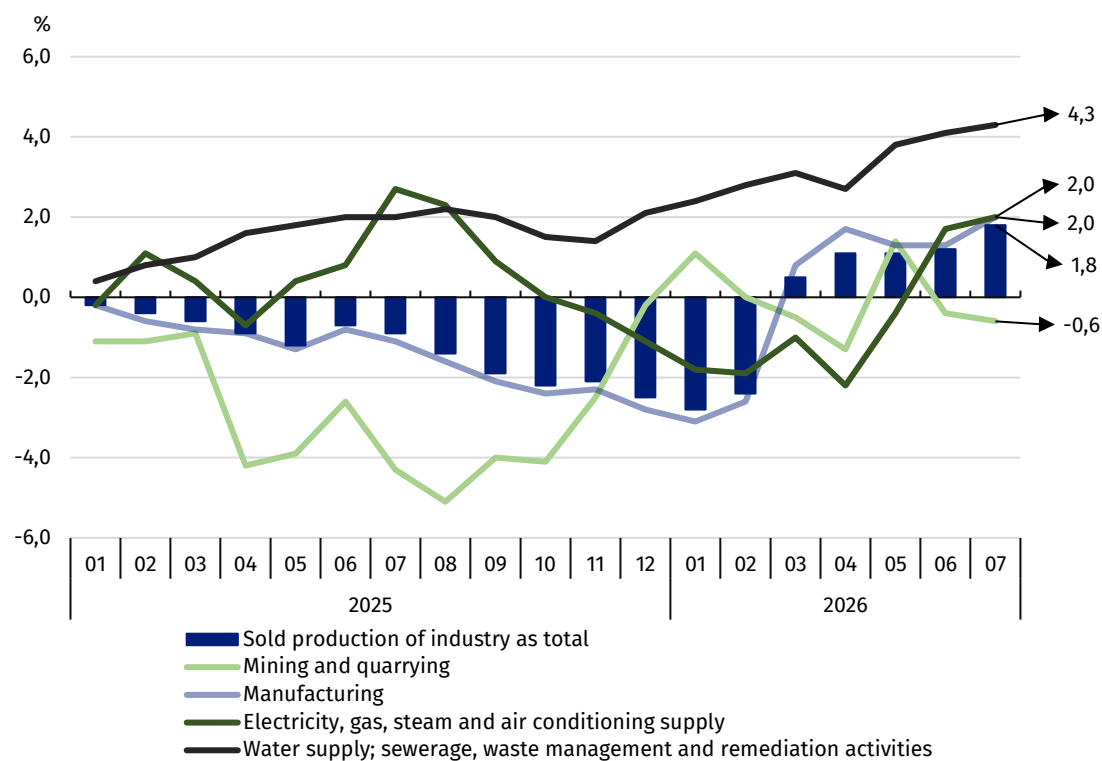
Chart 2. Prices changes of sold production of industry compared to the corresponding period of the previous year



In July 2026 an increase in the dynamics of prices of sold production of industry per year was observed by 2.8%

In July 2026 price increases were recorded in **mining and quarrying** section – by 3.8% and in **manufacturing** section – by 3.2%, as well as in **water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities** section – by 2.3%. Lower than in July 2025 were prices in **electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply** section – by 0.8%.
