Sold production of industry in July 2026¹

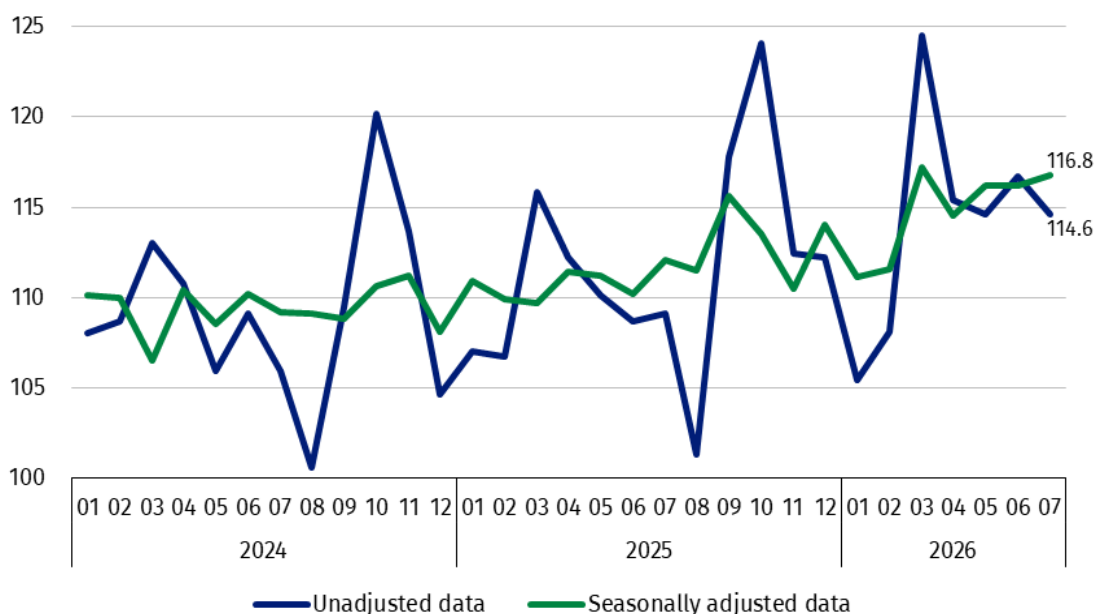
Increase in sold production of industry compared to July 2025

In July 2026, sold production of industry was by 5.1% higher than in July 2025 (when an increase was recorded by 3.0%), whereas in comparison with June 2026, it decreased by 1.8%. In the period January-July of 2026, sold production of industry was by 3.6% higher than in the corresponding period of 2025 (which saw an increase by 2.2%).

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in July 2026 sold production of industry reached the level higher by 4.2% than in the corresponding month of 2025 and by 0.5% higher than in June 2026.

After seasonal adjustment, sold production of industry in July 2026 increased by 4.2% per year

In July 2026, among the main industrial groupings there was an increase per year in the production of capital goods – by 11.1%, intermediate goods – by 6.3% and non-durable consumer goods – by 3.5%. A decrease was observed in the production of energy – by 2.2% and durable consumer goods – by 1.8%.

The highest y/y increase was recorded in the production of capital goods, while a decrease – in the production of energy

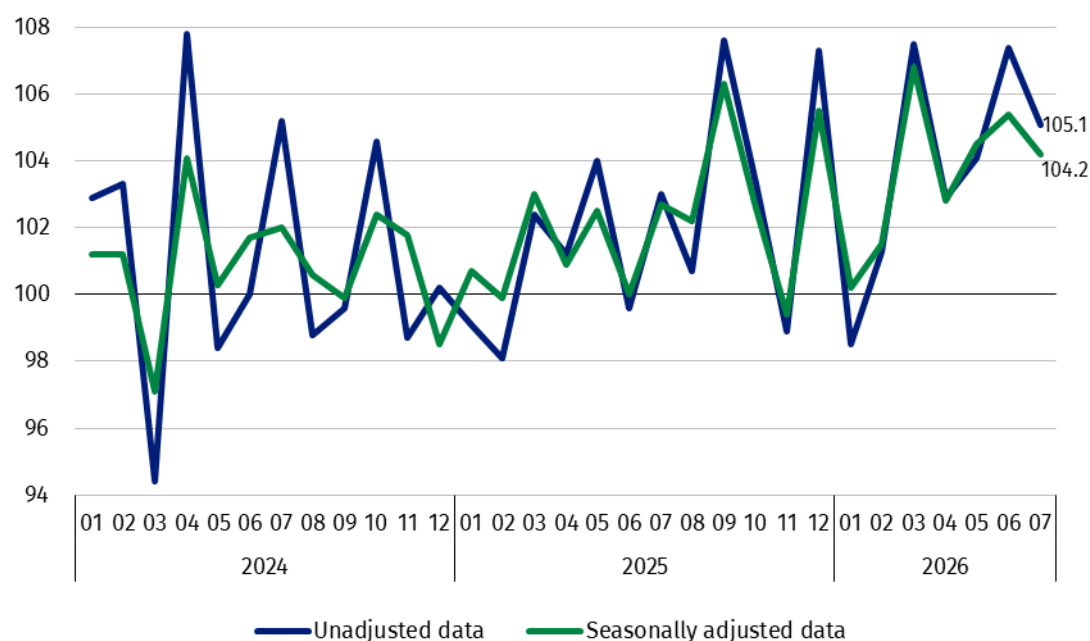

According to the preliminary data, in July 2026 an increase in sold production (in constant prices), compared to July 2025, was reported in 26 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others in manufacture of other transport equipment – by 31.5%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 21.0%, manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 17.3%, manufacture of beverages – by 16.9%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 14.1%, in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 13.8%, in waste collection, treatment and disposal activities; materials recovery – by 13.5%, in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – by 7.4%, in manufacture of paper and paper products – by 7.0%.

A decrease in sold production of industry, compared to July 2025, was recorded in 8 divisions, among others in manufacture of tobacco products – by 10.6%, manufacture of furniture – by 3.3%, manufacture of textiles – by 2.5%, manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 2.2%.

The share in total industry of sold production of divisions which recorded an increase per year amounted to 81.8%

(constant prices; corresponding month of previous year=100; unadjusted data)

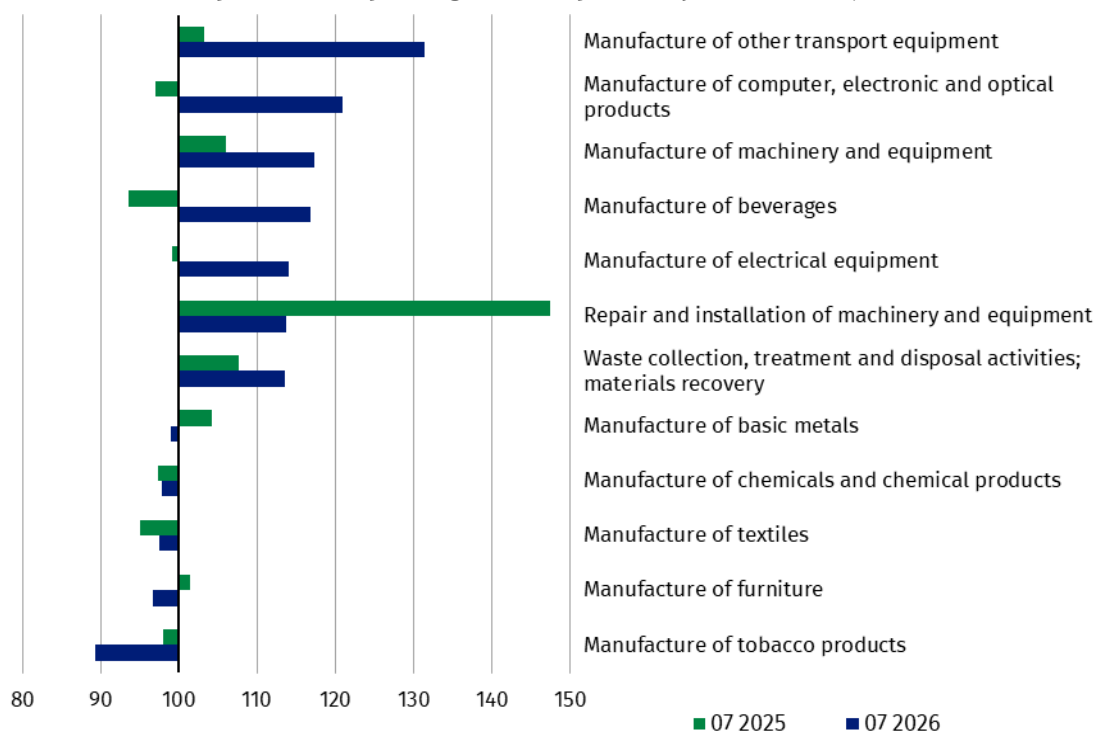
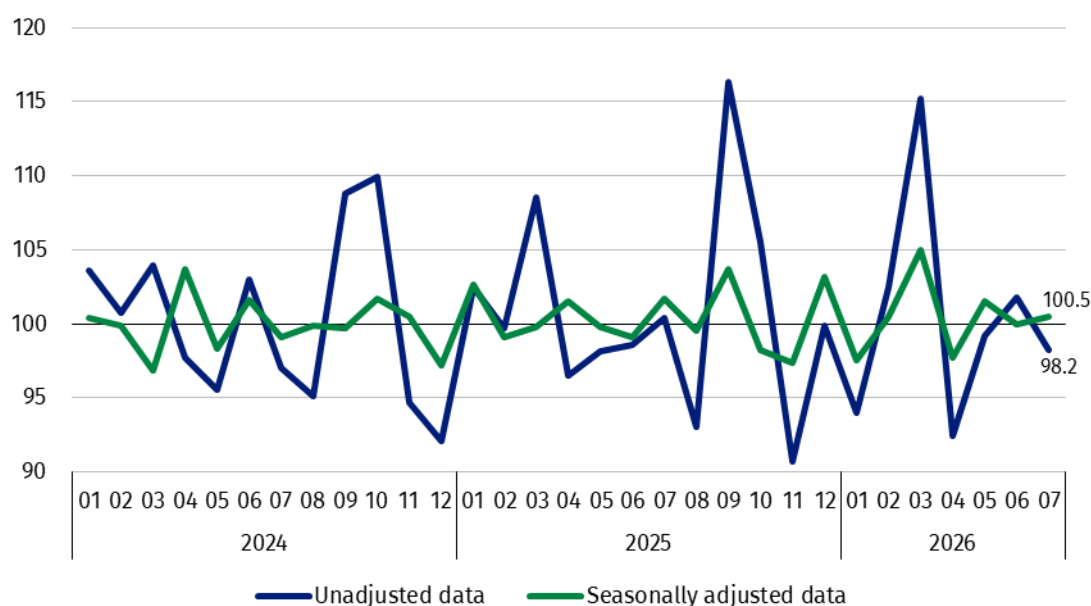


Chart 4. Sold production of industry (constant prices; previous month=100)

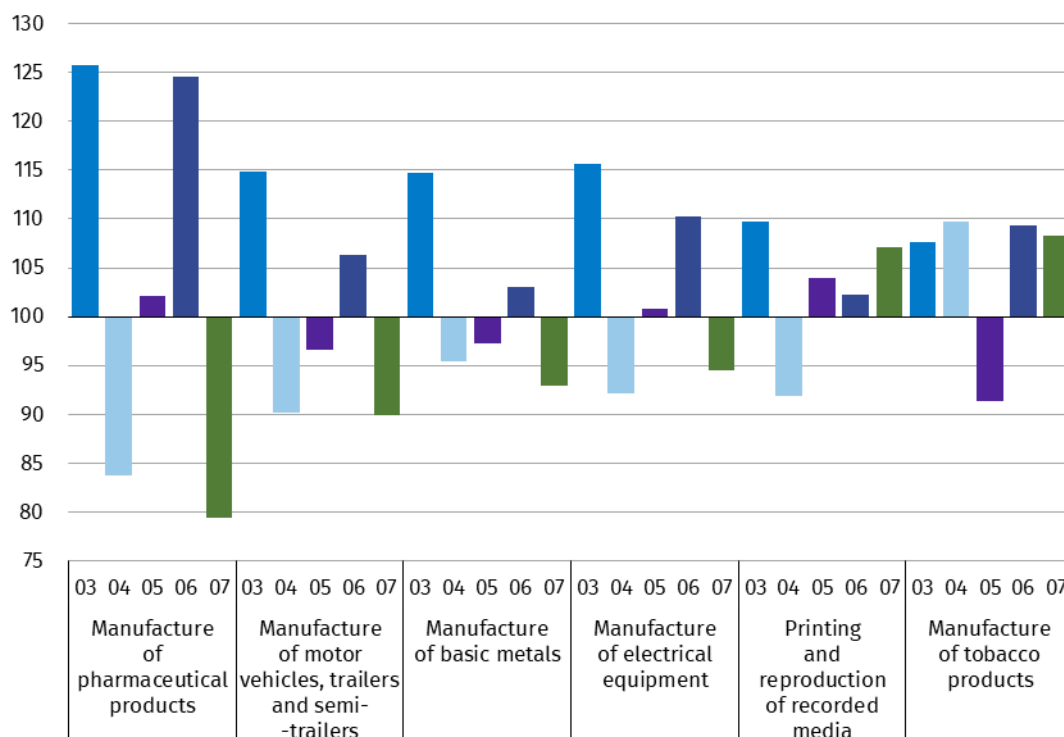


In July 2026, a decrease in sold production (in constant prices), compared to June 2026, was recorded in 20 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others in manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 10.1%, manufacture of basic metals – by 7.1%, manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker – by 5.8%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 5.5%, manufacture of metal products – by 4.0%, manufacture of paper and paper products – by 3.7%, manufacture of furniture – by 3.3%.

An increase in sold production of industry, compared to June 2026, was recorded in 14 divisions, among others in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 17.2%, in printing and reproduction of recorded media – by 7.1%, in manufacture of other transport equipment – by 2.3%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 2.0%, manufacture of beverages – by 1.8%, manufacture of food products – by 1.5%.

The share in total industry of sold production of divisions which recorded a decrease compared to June 2026 amounted to 58.1%

Methodological note

Data presented in this news release concern entities with 10 or more persons employed, conducting economic activity classified according to the Polish Classification of Activities (PKD 2007/NACE Rev. 2) to Industry, i.e. to the following sections: 'Mining and quarrying', 'Manufacturing', 'Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply', 'Water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities'.

Statistical unit, according to which the presented data are compiled, is a legal unit.

In addition, for the needs of European statistics, data on industrial production are also compiled according to the kind-of-activity unit (KAU).
