Average paid employment in the enterprise sector

In July 2026, the average paid employment in the enterprise sector was 0.1% higher than in June this year, whilst compared with July 2025 it was 0.8% lower.

Average monthly gross wage and salary in the enterprise sector

The average monthly gross wage and salary in the enterprise sector in July 2026 was 1.1% higher in nominal terms than in June this year, and 6.8% higher than in July 2025.

The presented data refer to entities from the enterprise sector, which is part of the national economy².

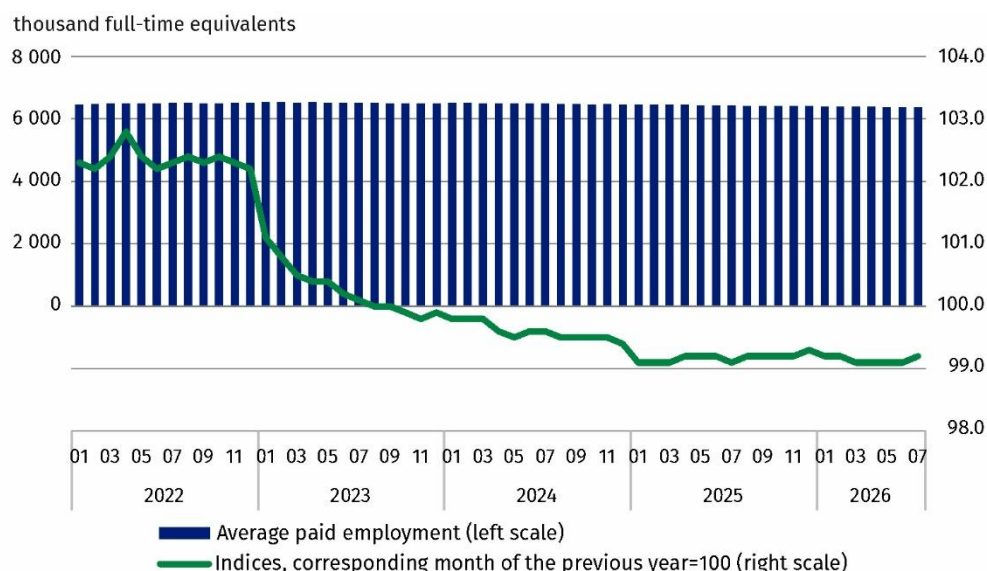

In January 2026, the statutory minimum salary increased to PLN 4 806, i.e., by 3.0% compared with 2025 (PLN 4 666). This also affected the change in the average monthly gross wage and salary in the enterprise sector

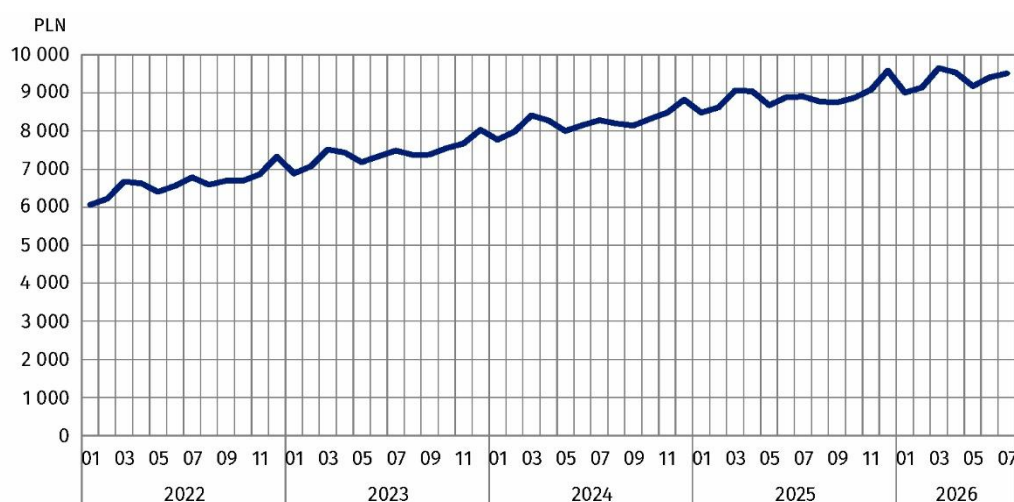
Chart 1. Average paid employment in the enterprise sector



The increase in the average monthly wage and salary in July 2026 compared with the previous month was due to additional payments, such as awards and bonuses – including quarterly, annual and discretionary payments – as well as awards for Forester’s Day, service anniversary awards and retirement severance pays (which, in addition to basic wages and salaries, are also included among the components of wages and salaries³).

The average monthly gross wage and salary in the enterprise sector includes the basic wage and salary and additional components of wages and salaries, including bonuses, awards, overtime pay and retirement severance pays

Methodological notes

The enterprise sector is part of the national economy and includes units with 10 or more employed persons, conducting business activities in the field of: forestry and logging; marine fishing; mining and quarrying; manufacturing; electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply; water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities; construction; wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles; transportation and storage; accommodation and food service activities; information and communication; real estate activities; activities of head offices; management consultancy activities; architectural and engineering activities; technical testing and analysis; advertising and market research; other professional, scientific and technical activities; administrative and support service activities; arts, entertainment and recreation; repair of computers and personal and household goods; other personal service activities⁴.

Data for the national economy are published quarterly, e.g. in *Statistical bulletin*.

Due to the short deadline for units to provide data as part of the survey with the use of DG-1 form, the results presented are preliminary. In the absence of complete records at the date of preparation of the report, it is permissible to report estimated data, and if data reported in previous periods need to be corrected, the changes are included only in the cumulative data.
