

Domestic deliveries and consumption of selected consumer goods per capita in 2025

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 **9.7%**

An increase in the meat deliveries to the domestic market compared with 2024

In 2025 domestic deliveries¹ of meat (including pork, beef, veal and poultry) amounted to 5061 thousand tonnes and were higher by 9.7% compared with the previous year. The deliveries of raw meat from animals for slaughter increased by 10.3%, as well as deliveries of poultry meat by 8.9%.

The domestic market supply of selected food goods

In 2025, deliveries of the following foodstuffs were definitely higher than in the previous year: chocolate (including chocolates, chocolate products and white chocolate); pasta; meat and sugar. Compared to 2024, the deliveries of rye flour; margarine and reduced and low fat spreads (excluding liquid margarine); meat and offal products from animals for slaughter; wine and mead; beer from malt; mineral waters and soft drinks were much lower.

In 2025, among the surveyed foodstuffs, a high increase in chocolate and pasta deliveries was observed

In 2025 a significant increase in the consumption of hen eggs, sugar and meat was recorded. However, the consumption of alcoholic drinks was dropped

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² Data about consumption was compiled using balance method: production enlarged by import, reduced by export, decreases and losses of agricultural products at producers' and in turnover including changes of stocks level. Besides, production of raw materials is diminished by their usage for production purposes. Consumption per capita was based on a number of population data for 30 June.

³ Data concerns farming years i.e. period from 1 July of the previous year to 30 June of the given year.
