In March 2026, the median monthly gross wage and salary decreased by 2.1% in nominal terms compared with February 2026, whilst it increased by 7.6% compared with March 2025. During the same period, the average monthly gross wage and salary decreased by 2.7% in nominal terms compared with February 2026, whilst it increased by 6.6% compared with March 2025.

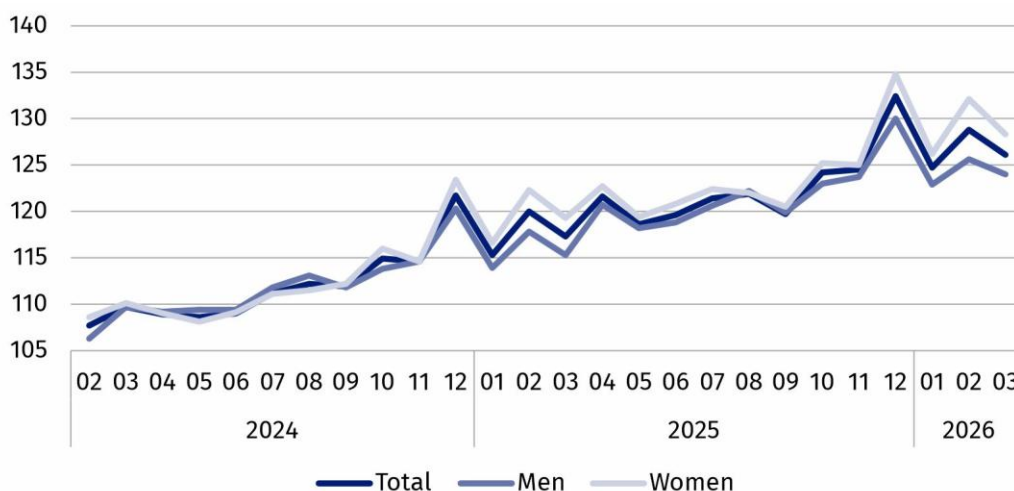
In March 2026, the median monthly gross wage and salary was 22.4% lower than the average monthly gross wage and salary in that month

Median monthly gross wage and salary in the national economy

The median gross wage and salary in the national economy in March 2026 was PLN 7 530.45. It means that half of the employees received a wage or salary not higher than this amount, and the other half received a wage or salary not lower than this amount. The median wage and salary varied depending on sex – among men it was PLN 7 657.56 (101.7% of the total value), whilst among women it was PLN 7 407.10 (98.4% of the total value). In terms of entity size, the highest median wage and salary was recorded, as in previous periods, in entities with 1 000 or more employed persons – PLN 8 695.04 (115.5% of the total value), whilst the lowest was in entities with 9 or fewer employed persons – at the level of the minimum wage, i.e. PLN 4 806.00 (63.8% of the total value).

In entities with 9 or fewer employed persons, the median gross wage and salary remained at the level of the minimum wage

01.2024 = 100



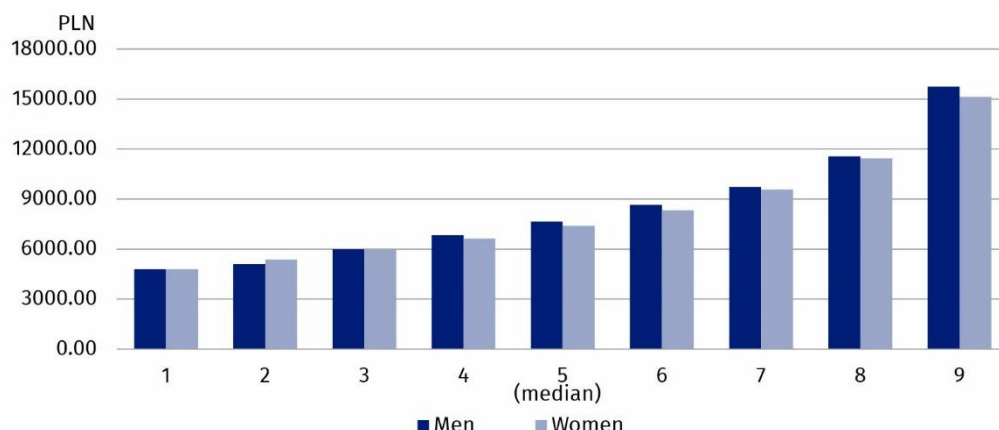
Deciles of monthly gross wages and salaries in the national economy

In March 2026, the lowest earning 10% of employees received a wage or salary of no more than PLN 4 806.00 (the first decile). In contrast, the highest earning 10% of employees received a wage or salary of at least PLN 15 424.85 (the ninth decile). In most deciles, wages

In March 2026, only in the second decile wages and salaries of women were higher than those of men, the difference amounted to PLN 270.57

and salaries varied by sex of the employees. The largest nominal difference in wages and salaries by sex occurred in the ninth decile and amounted to PLN 609.50 in favour of men.

Chart 2. Deciles of monthly gross wages and salaries in the national economy by sex in March 2026



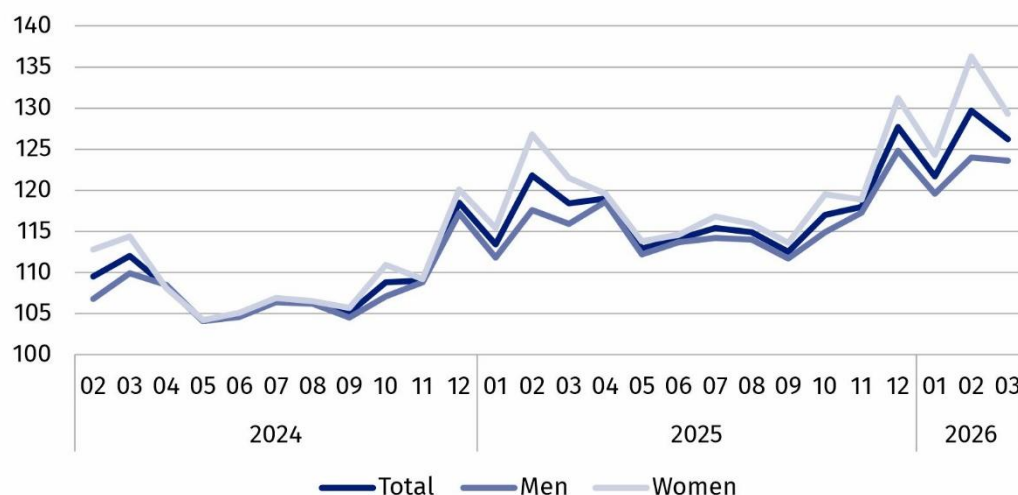
In March 2026, the highest earning 10% of men received a wage or salary of at least PLN 15 750.29. During the same period, the highest earning 10% of women received a wage or salary of at least PLN 15 140.79

Average monthly gross wage and salary in the national economy

The average wage and salary in the national economy in March 2026 was PLN 9 698.95, among men – PLN 9 994.19 (which represented 103.0% of the total average wage and salary), whilst among women – PLN 9 397.50 (96.9% of the total average wage and salary). In terms of entity size, the highest average wage and salary was recorded, as in previous periods, in entities with 1 000 or more employed persons – PLN 11 307.95 (116.6% of the total value), whilst the lowest was in entities with 9 or fewer employed persons – PLN 6 301.72 (65.0% of the total value).

In March 2026, in entities with 9 or fewer employed persons, women's average monthly gross wage and salary was PLN 271.14 higher than men's average monthly gross wage and salary

Chart 3. Indices of average monthly gross nominal wage and salary in the national economy 01.2024 = 100



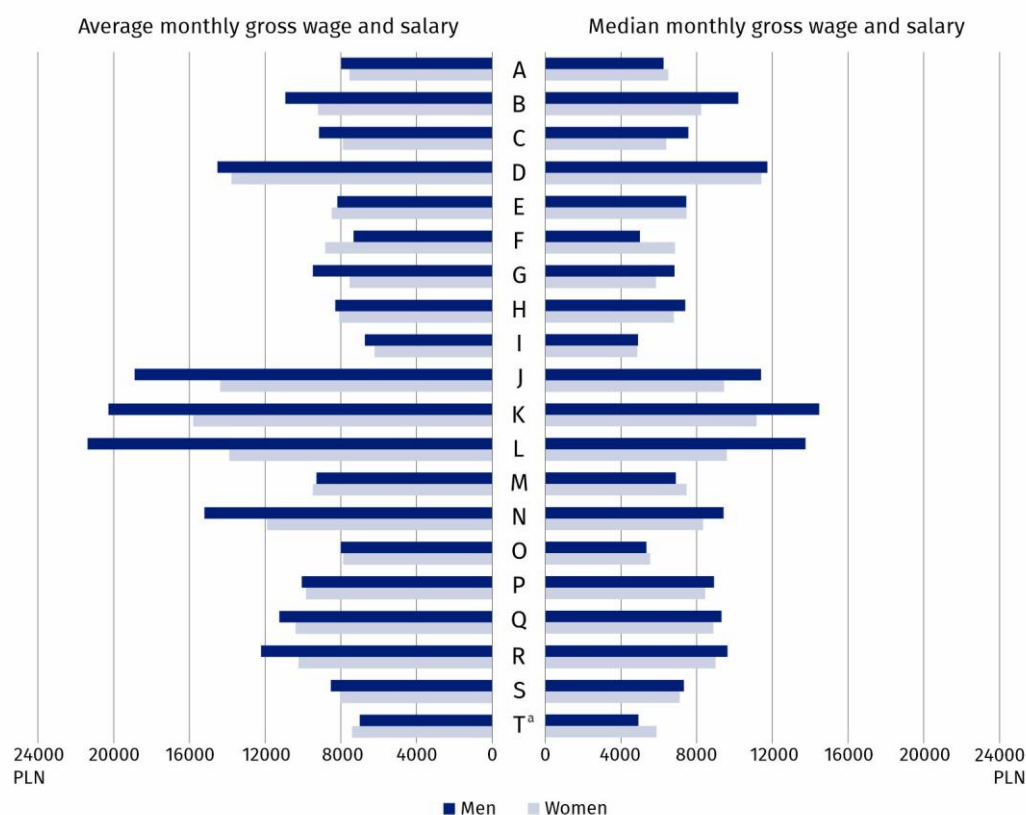

Wages and salaries also varied by kind of activity. In March 2026, the highest median wage and salary, amounting to PLN 13 000.00, was recorded in the Telecommunication, computer programming, consulting, computing infrastructure and other information service activities section (section K). As in the previous month, in 14 out of the 20 PKD 2025/NACE Rev. 2.1 sections analysed, men's median wage and salary was higher than women's median wage and salary. The largest percentage difference occurred in the Financial and insurance activities section (section L) – men earned 43.4% more than women. In 6 sections, women's median wage and salary was higher than men's median wage and salary, and the largest

In the majority of the sections analysed, the average monthly gross wage and salary and the median wage and salary were higher among men than among women

percentage difference occurred in the Construction section (section F) – women earned 37.0% more than men.

The highest average wage and salary in March 2026, as in February, was recorded in the Telecommunication, computer programming, consulting, computing infrastructure and other information service activities section (section K), where it stood at PLN 18 562.48. The largest percentage difference between men's average wage and salary and women's average wage and salary was in the Financial and insurance activities section (section L) – it stood at 53.9% in favour of men. In 4 sections, women's average wage and salary was higher than men's average wage and salary; the largest percentage difference, as in previous periods, occurred in the Construction section (section F) – it stood at 20.5% in favour of women.

Minimum gross wage

In March 2026, 12.2% of employees¹ received a gross wage or salary not exceeding the applicable minimum wage. This share was higher among men (14.0%) than among women (10.4%). Differences were also observed between age groups – the highest share was recorded in the 65 or over age group (14.8%), whilst the lowest was in the 55–64 age group (11.6%). Depending on entity size, this share ranged from 1.9% in entities with 1 000 or more employed persons to 46.5% in entities with 9 or fewer employed persons. In the breakdown by kind of economic activity, the highest share was recorded in the Accommodation and

In March 2026, in 16 PKD 2025/NACE Rev. 2.1 sections, men's average monthly gross wage and salary was higher than women's average monthly gross wage and salary

In 2026, the minimum gross wage is PLN 4 806.00

¹ The data refer to all wage and salaried jobs, i.e. both employees in total and those whose wage or salary does not exceed the applicable minimum wage, who hold more than one wage or salaried job are counted as many times as the number of wage and salaried jobs they hold.

food service activities section (section I) – 38.9%, whilst the lowest was in the Public administration and defence; compulsory social security section (section P) – 0.6%.

Starting with the data for January 2026, the survey results are compiled in accordance with the Polish Classification of Activities 2025, introduced by the Regulation of the Council of Ministers of 18 December 2024 (Journal of Laws of 2024, item 1936). Due to this change, data broken down by PKD/NACE section, as well as by sector of the national economy, are not fully comparable with results from previous periods.

The presented data on wages and salaries cover monetary payments under the title of an employment relationship or a service relationship to employees, as well as payments under contracts of mandate, contracts to perform a specified task and agency agreements, if these contracts were concluded with the same employer or to the benefit of the same employer with whom a given person is employed on the basis of an employment relationship.
