Sold production of industry in August 2026¹

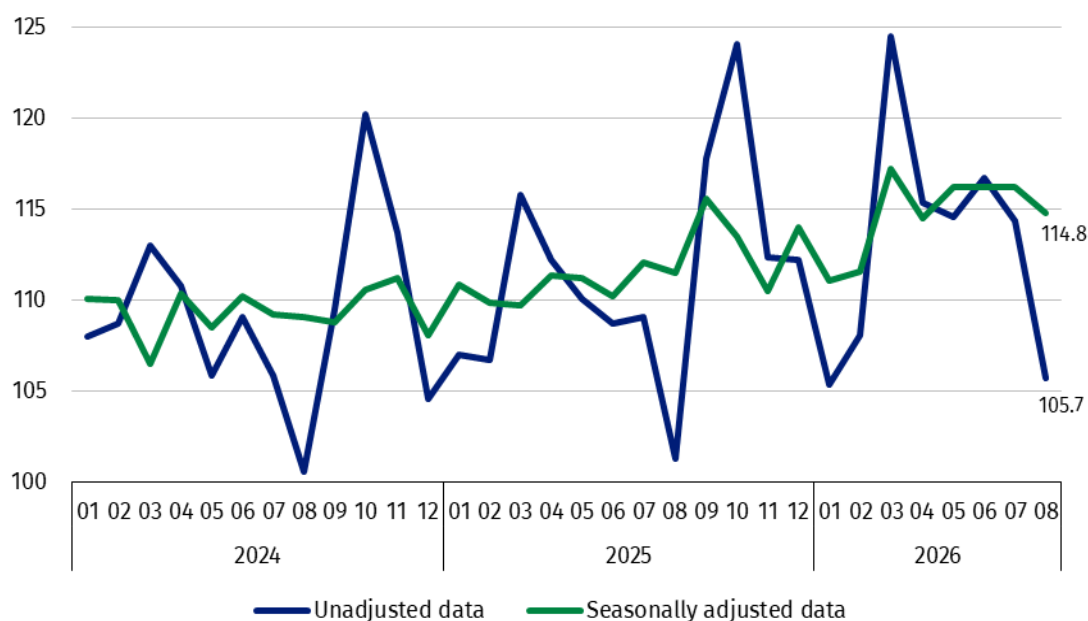
Increase in sold production of industry compared to August 2025

In August 2026, sold production of industry was by 4.3% higher than in August 2025 (when an increase was recorded by 0.7%), whereas in comparison with July 2026, it decreased by 7.5%. In the period January-August of 2026, sold production of industry was by 3.5% higher than in the corresponding period of 2025 (which saw an increase by 2.0%).

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in August 2026 sold production of industry reached the level higher by 3.0% than in the corresponding month of 2025 and by 1.2% lower than in July 2026.

After seasonal adjustment, sold production of industry in August 2026 increased by 3.0% per year

In August 2026, among the main industrial groupings there was an increase per year in the production of intermediate goods – by 8.5%, non-durable consumer goods – by 4.8% and capital goods – by 4.7%. A decrease was observed in the production of durable consumer goods – by 7.0% and energy – by 0.5%.

The highest y/y increase was recorded in the production of intermediate goods, while a decrease – in the production of durable consumer goods

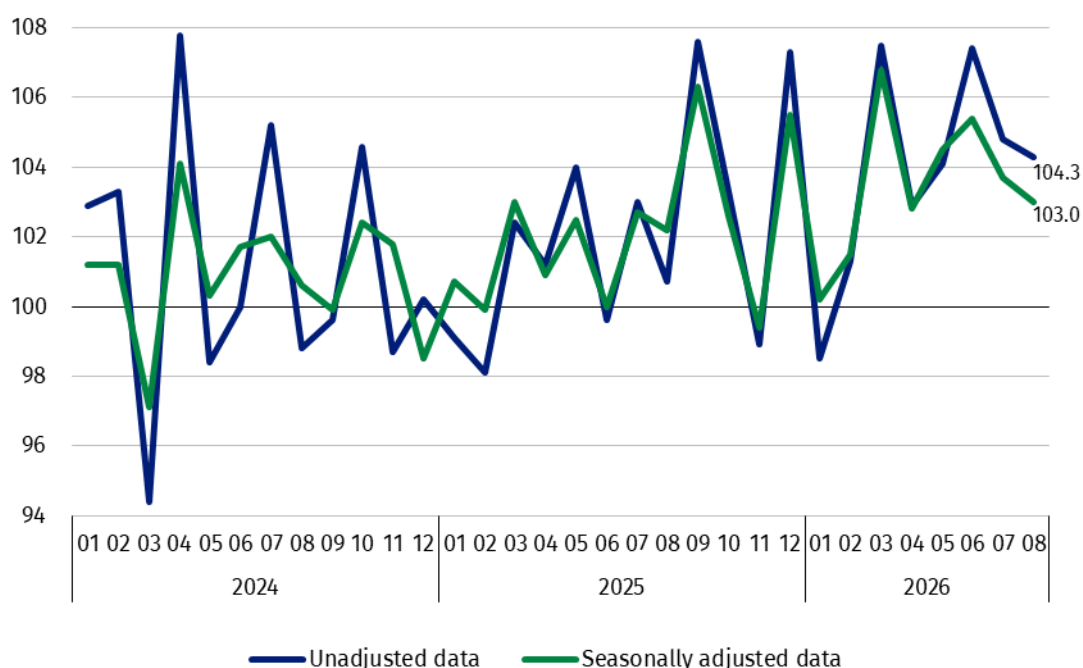

According to the preliminary data, in August 2026 an increase in sold production (in constant prices), compared to August 2025, was reported in 25 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others in manufacture of electrical equipment – by 18.7%, manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 12.8%, in waste collection, treatment and disposal activities; materials recovery – by 10.8%, in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – by 10.5%, in manufacture of paper and paper products – by 8.8%, manufacture of basic metals – by 7.2%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 7.1%, manufacture of other transport equipment – by 6.7%.

A decrease in sold production of industry, compared to August 2025, was recorded in 9 divisions, among others in manufacture of tobacco products – by 11.7%, manufacture of textiles – by 4.9%, manufacture of furniture – by 2.3%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 1.5%.

The share in total industry of sold production of divisions which recorded an increase per year amounted to 80.0%

(constant prices; corresponding month of previous year=100; unadjusted data)

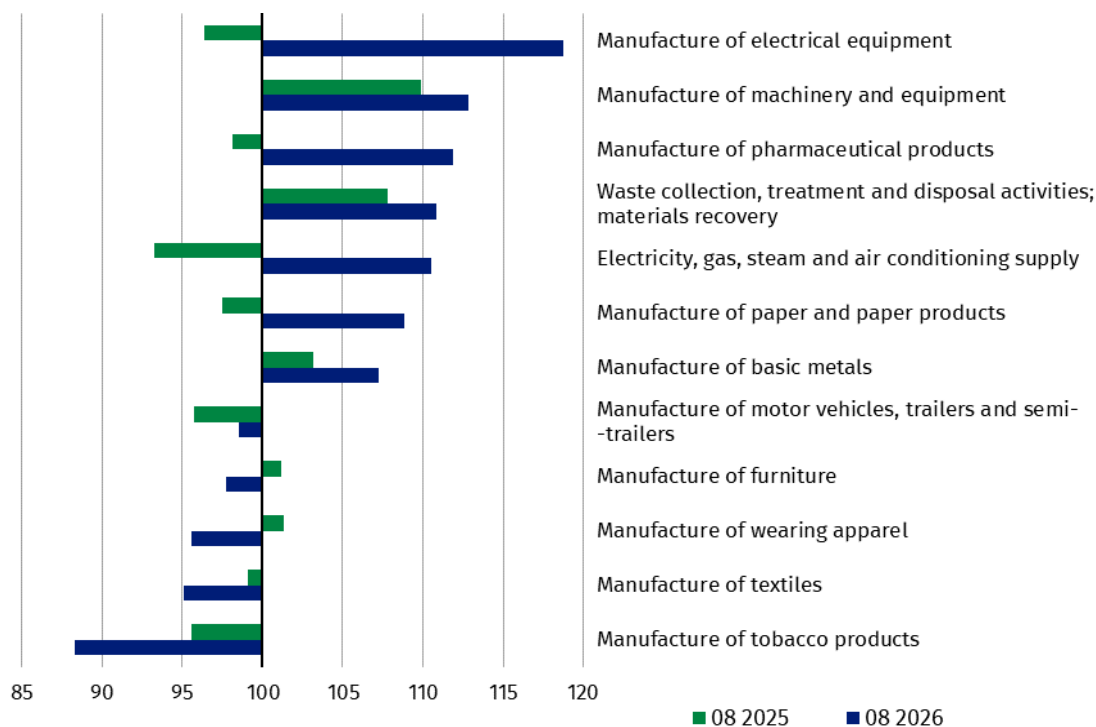
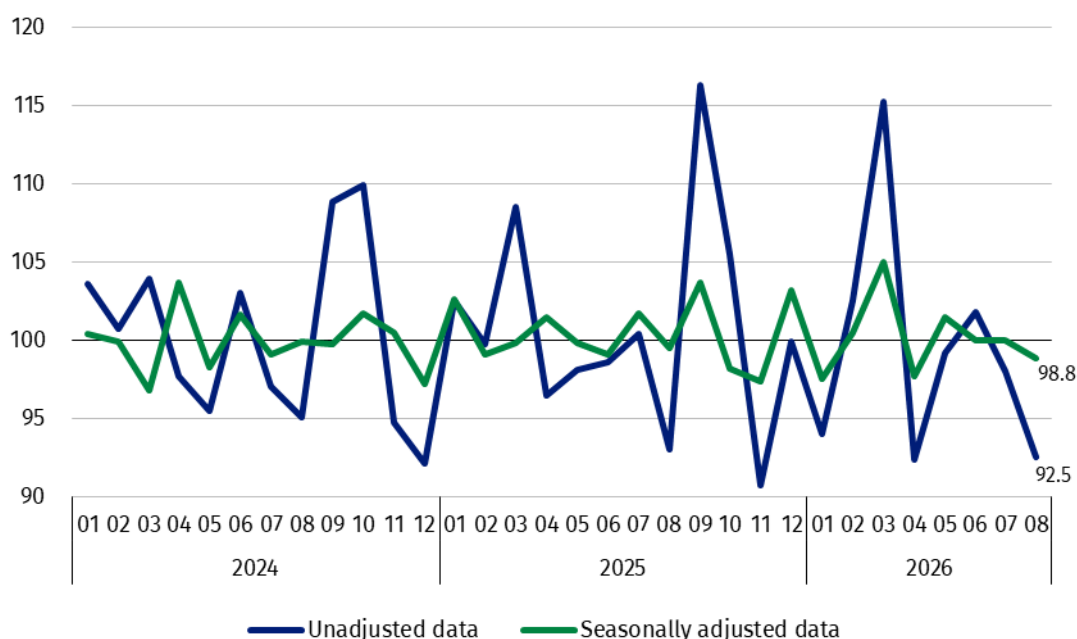


Chart 4. Sold production of industry (constant prices; previous month=100)

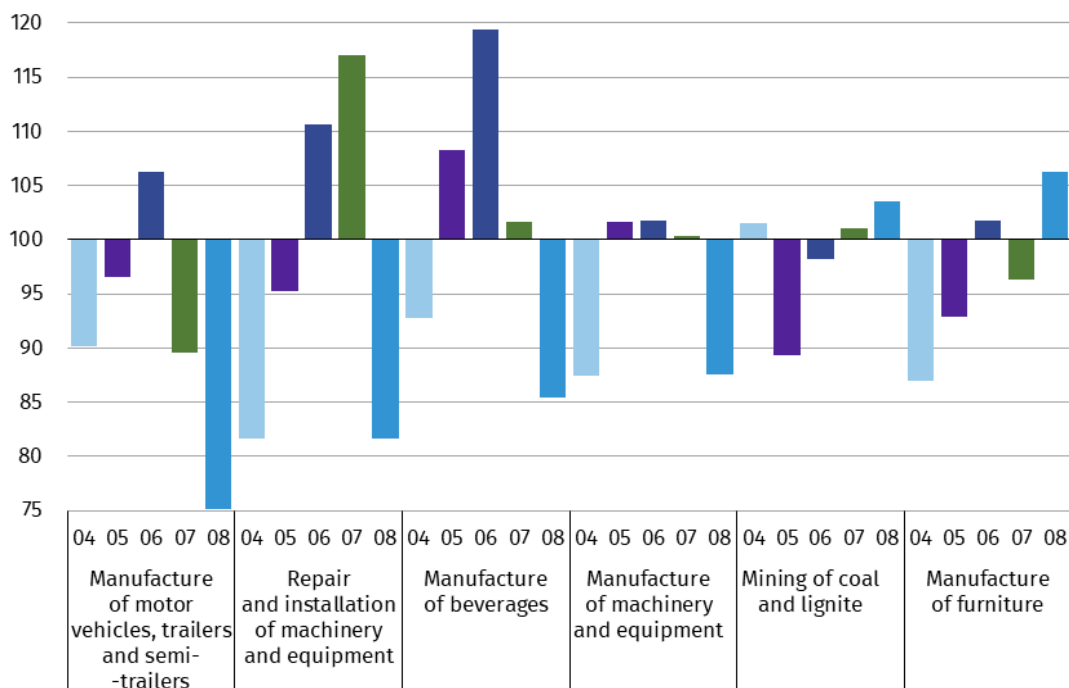


In August 2026, a decrease in sold production (in constant prices), compared to July 2026, was recorded in 28 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others in manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 24.8%, in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 18.4%, in manufacture of beverages – by 14.6%, manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 12.4%, manufacture of metal products – by 10.5%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 10.1%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products and manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 9.3% each, manufacture of paper and paper products – by 8.7%.

An increase in sold production of industry, compared to July 2026, was recorded in 5 divisions, among others in manufacture of furniture – by 6.2%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 3.5%.

The share in total industry of sold production of divisions which recorded a decrease compared to July 2026 amounted to 80.3%

Methodological note

Data presented in this news release concern entities with 10 or more persons employed, conducting economic activity classified according to the Polish Classification of Activities (PKD 2007/NACE Rev. 2) to Industry, i.e. to the following sections: 'Mining and quarrying', 'Manufacturing', 'Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply', 'Water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities'.

Statistical unit, according to which the presented data are compiled, is a legal unit. Methodology of compiling data on sold production of industry is presented in the methodological report [Industrial production surveys](#).

In addition, for the needs of European statistics, data on industrial production are also compiled according to the kind-of-activity unit (KAU).
