According to preliminary data, the prices of sold production of industry in August 2026 increased both compared to August 2025 – by 4.2%, to the previous month – by 0.6%.

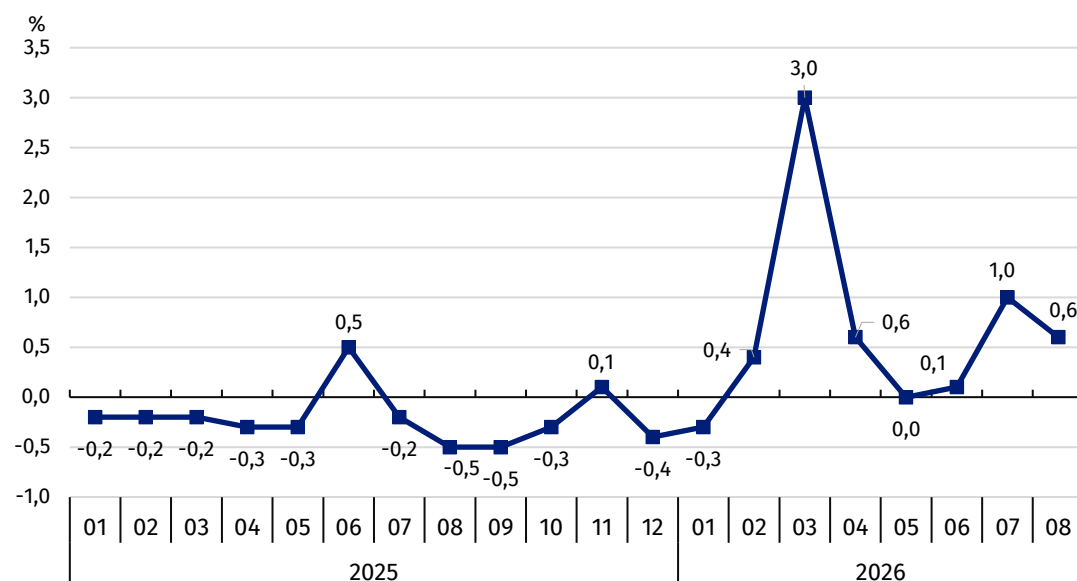

Prices changes of sold production of industry in August 2026 compared to the previous month

According to preliminary data the prices of sold production of industry in August 2026, increased by 0.6%. This is another month in which prices have risen.

Chart 1. Prices changes of sold production of industry compared to the previous month



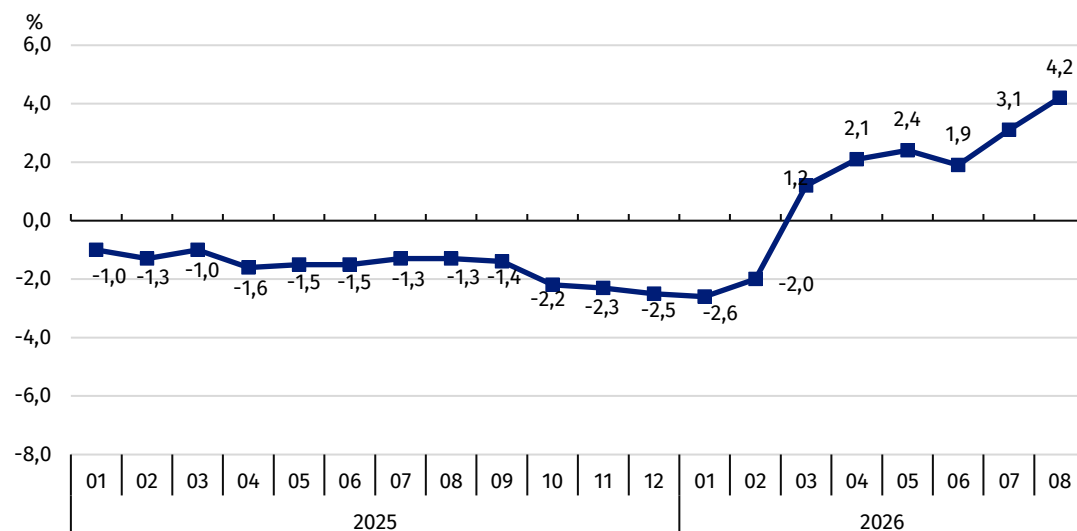
In August 2026 prices of sold production of industry increased by 0.6% compared to July 2026

Price increases in August 2026 were observed across all sections, including **mining and quarrying** - by 1.5%, the **electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply** - by 0.7%, **manufacturing** - by 0.6%, as well as **water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities** by 0.1%.

Prices changes of sold production of industry in August 2026 compared to the corresponding month of the previous year

In August 2026 the prices of sold production of industry compared to the corresponding month of the previous year increased by 4.2%. In annual terms a rise in prices has been recorded since March of this year.

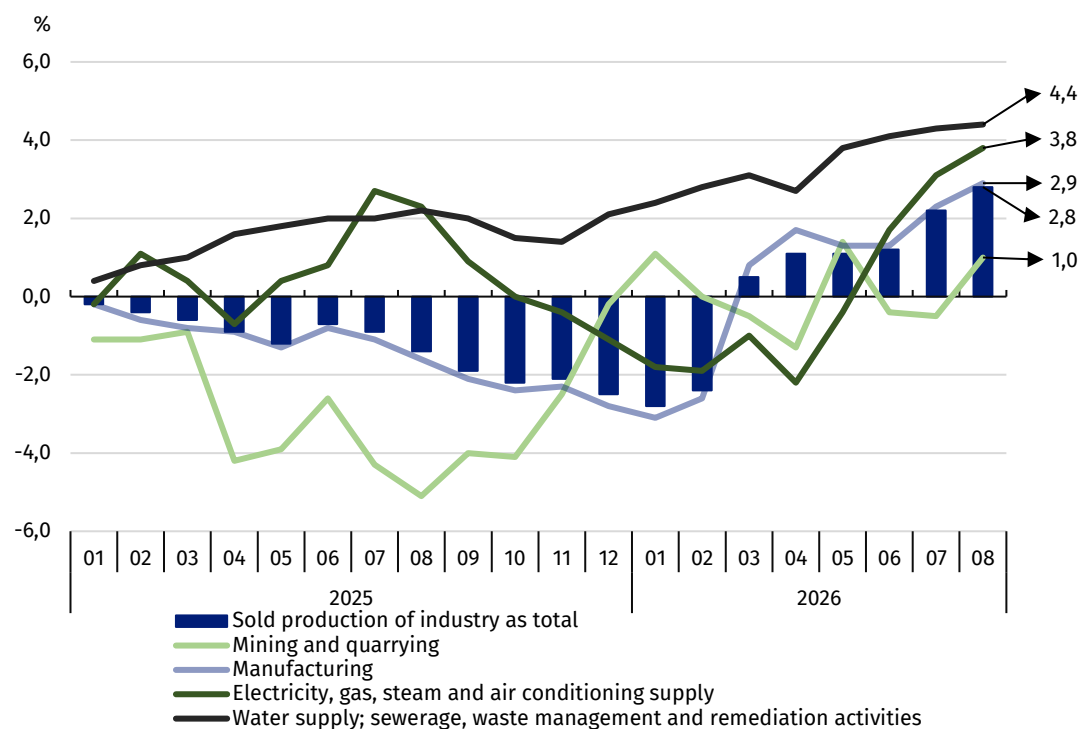
Chart 2. Prices changes of sold production of industry compared to the corresponding period of the previous year



In August 2026 an increase in the dynamics of prices of sold production of industry per year was observed by 4.2%

Price increases in August 2026 were recorded across all sections, including **mining and quarrying** section - by 6.4% and in **manufacturing** section - by 4.6%, **water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities** section- by 2.2%. as well as **electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply** section - by 1.4%.
